Rider University Footnotes:

-As of September 1, 2015 the New Jersey Department of Education requires students to take and pass all sections of the Praxis – The Core Academic Skills for Educators Test (Test Code 5751) prior to entry into a teacher preparation program. Prior to student teaching.

-CCM students must earn a grade of “C+” in all Education courses for transfer.

-Education students are required to have a GPA of 3.00+

⚠ Students have a number of options to satisfy this requirement; courses will be evaluated on an individual basis.

For transfer credit County College of Morris students must have a grade of “C” or higher in all courses. (No transfer credit will be accepted for any course with a grade of “C-“or below)
